For Cleaning and Disinfecting

In food, milk, beverage processing plants, hospitals, institutions, public rooms, homes, industrial areas, conveyances, etc.

Apply at least two ounces of QUAT to one gallon of water.

In instances, i.e., operating rooms where surfaces are heavily contaminated with soil and/or organic matter, apply solution twice to ensure complete protection. For maximum germicidal and detergent activity, surfaces to be treated should be wet thoroughly.

QUAT is a potent broad spectrum disinfectant which fights most pathogens and acts successfully and leaves a bacterial residual protective film which will protect treated surfaces against growth of most gram negative, gram positive and highly contagious resistant strains of bacteria.

For Cleaning and Sanitizing

Apply at least one ounce of QUAT to one gallon of water. Allow at least five minutes of contact with surface before rinsing.

For Cleaning and Deterging

Apply one ounce of QUAT to one or two gallons of water.

Active Ingredients: 7.2%

- Sodium ~~Carbonate~~ **Meta Silicate**
 - n-Allyl (50% C₁₂, 50% C₁₄) 1.7%
 - dimethyl ethylbenzyl ammonium chlorides
 - Tetra sodium salt of ethylene diamine hydrochloride
- Total 7.2%

Inert Ingredients: 92.8%

- Water
 - Nonyl phenoxy polyethoxy ethanol
 - Sodium tripolyphosphate
 - Color trace
 - Ethylene Glycol Monebutyl Ether
- Total 92.8%

QUAT is a concentrated detergent-disinfectant and must be diluted before using. Keep out of reach of children.

Solutions of QUAT should not come in contact with food.
