Complete Vegetation Killer

Your Submissions of June 6, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. In the Storage and Disposal Section add the heading Container Disposal. Above "Pesticide wastes are toxic" add the heading Pesticide Disposal.
 - b. Add the following statements required by 40 Code of Federal Regulations Section 162.10 to the appropriate sections of the labeling:

Precautionary Statements
 Hazards to Humans (and Domestic Animals)
CAUTION
 Environmental Hazards; Physical or Chemical Hazards
 Directions For Use.
 It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Refer to the attached sample label.

- c. Modify "Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds" to read:

Do not apply directly to water.

d. Modify the referral statement to read:

See side panel for additional precautionary statements.

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

The amended labeling and formulations supersede all previously accepted ones.

DIRECTIONS: This product may be applied at any time of the year, EXCEPT when ground is frozen. Best results are obtained after vegetation has emerged, in late spring or early summer. Use power sprayers, compressed air hand sprayers, or an ordinary sprinkling can. No dilution or agitation is required.

GENERAL WEED CONTROL: To control most weeds on non-cropland areas such as parking lots, fence rows, railroad sidings and storage yards, spray at the rate of 1 to 2 gallons for each 1,000 square feet.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area with container tightly closed when not in use. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office.
