PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

GENERAL INFORMATION

This product is a specially formulated non-selective vegetation killer for controlling a wide range of annual and perennial weeds and grasses. Apply undiluted as a spray on non-cropland areas where bare ground is desired. Control will vary with the amount of chemical applied, soil type, rainfall and other conditions. This product is non-corrosive to metal surfaces. Especially compounded for industrial and municipal weed control.

Important: Do not apply on or near desirable trees, shrubs, grasses or other plants, or on areas where roots of desirable vegetation may extend. Do not contaminate irrigation or domestic water supplies. Thoroughly clean application equipment with some good detergent after each use.

CAUTION: Vapors from this product may injure susceptible plants in the immediate vicinity.

Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift.

Avoid spray drift to susceptible plants, as this product may injure cotton, beans, peas, grapes, ornamentals, etc.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product may be applied at any time of the year, EXCEPT when ground is frozen. Best results are obtained after vegetation has emerged, in late spring or early summer. Use power sprayers, compressed air hand sprayers, or an ordinary sprinkling can. No dilution or agitation is required.

GENERAL WEED CONTROL: To control most weeds on non-cropland areas such as parking lots, fence rows, railroad sidings and storage yards, spray at the rate of 1 to 2 gallons for each 1,000 square feet.
