

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Mix one gallon of TRIGGER in ten gallons of water. Uniformly spray this mixture over 1,000 square feet of soil surface. Thoroughly wet all foilage to insure contact action. Best results are obtained when applications are made during or soon after weed emergence while growth is succulent. Where vegetation is tall and dense use 12 gallons of TRIGGER in ten gallons of water. Although TRIGGER will burn plant foliage, much of its activity is through the roots and there fore adequate rainfall to move the chemical into the root is necessary.

Under conditions where the rainfall is high and the growing season long, a second application may be necessary to maintain a weed-free soil surface.

Care must be taken to keep this herbicide away from desirable flower beds, lawns and shrubs. Do not apply over roots of valuable trees, or woody ornamental plants. Only apply herbicide outside of the drip line of trees.
