ALFALFA, CLOVER: Aphids, Alfalfa Caterpillar—1/2 to 1/4 pt per acre
Grasshoppers, Leafhoppers, Cutworms (climbing), Red Spider Mites, Alfalfa Weevil Larvae—1/2 to 1/4 pt per acre

APPLES, PEACHES, PEARS, PLUMS, CHERRIES (SOUR): Aphids, Red Spider Mites—1/4 to 1/2 pt per acre
Grasshoppers, Lygus Bugs, Red-banded Leaf Roller—1/2 to 1/4 pt per acre

ARTICHOKES: Aphids—1/2 to 1/4 pt per acre
Plume Moth—1/2 to 1/4 pt per acre

BEANS, PEAS, POTATOES, CUCUMBERS, TOMATOES: Aphids, Grasshoppers, Leafhoppers, Red Spider Mites, Mexican Bean Beetle—1/2 to 1/4 pt per acre

BROCCOLI, BRUSSELS SPROUTS, CABBAGE: Aphids, Cabbage Looper, Imported Cabbage Worm, Cutworm, Leafhoppers—1/2 to 1/4 pt per acre

AGRICULTURAL CHEMICALS

MUSTARD GREENS: Aphids—1 1/2 pints per acre. Cabbage Looper, Imported Cabbage Worm, False Chinch Bug, Dipterous Leafminer (Adult), Grasshopper, Leafhopper, Red Spider Mites—1 1/2 pints per acre.

OKRA: Aphids—1 1/2 pints per acre. Cutworms (climbing), Corn Earworms, Green Stinkbugs, Red Spider Mites, Velvet Bean Caterpillar—1 1/2 pints per acre.

ONIONS (Including Green Onions): Thrips, Cutworms (Climbing)—1 1/2 pints per acre.

RASPBERRIES: Aphids—1 1/2 pints per acre. Led Spider Mites, Leafhoppers, Fruit Tree Leafroller—1 1/2 pints per acre.

SORGHUM MILO: For Forage and Grain: Aphids—1 1/2 pints per acre. Corn Earworm Webworms—1 1/2 pints per acre. Fall Armyworms—1 1/2 pints per acre.

SPINACH: Aphids, Grasshoppers, Leafhoppers, Salt-marsh Caterpillars, Cutworm (climbing), Lygus Bugs, Corn Earworm—1 1/2 pints per acre.

STRAWBERRIES: Aphids, Red Spider Mites—1 1/2 pints per acre. Grasshoppers, Strawberry Leaf Roller, Salt Marsh Caterpillar, Lygus Bugs—1 1/2 pints per acre.

WALNUTS: Aphids—1 1/2 pints per acre. Red Spider Mites, Omnivorous Looper, Orange Tortrix, Fruit Tree Leafroller, Western Tussock Moth—1 1/2 pints per acre.
