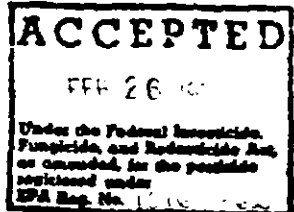


RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE

Due to very high acute toxicity to humans and birds. For retail sale to and use only by certified applicator or persons under their direct supervision and only for those uses covered by the certified applicator's certification. Direct supervision for this product is defined as the certified applicator being physically present during application, mixing, loading, repair and cleaning of application equipment. Commercial certified applicators must also ensure that all persons involved in these activities are informed of the precautionary statements.

CALL a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to Parathion and describe his condition. IF BREATHING HAS STOPPED—Start artificial respiration immediately and maintain until doctor sees victim. IF SWALLOWED—Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention. IN CASE OF CONTACT—Immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. See doctor immediately.



Safety goggles or a face shield must be worn when the system is under pressure. All other protective clothing and equipment required for use with open systems must be available nearby. IF APPLICATION IS PERFORMED USING AN ENCLOSED CAB OR COCKPIT, THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT MAY BE WORN AS AN ALTERNATIVE:

Clean long-sleeved shirt and long-legged pants. All other protective clothing and equipment required for use during application must be available in the cab and must be worn when exiting the cab into treated areas. If used for this purpose, contaminated clothing may not be brought back into the cab unless in an enclosure such as a plastic bag.

REMEMBER—THIS CLOTHING IS NOT INTENDED TO PROTECT YOU DURING REPAIR AND CLEANING OF APPLICATION EQUIPMENT OR DURING EARLY REENTRY! REFER TO THE INSTRUCTIONS ABOVE.

HEAVY FLAGGERS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED DURING AERIAL APPLICATION.

CAUTION! If pesticide comes in contact with skin, wash off with soap and water, and contact a physician immediately. Always wash hands, face, and arms with soap and water before smoking, eating, drinking, or sleeping.

AFTER USE: Wash gloves with soap and water before removing. Take off all work clothes and shoes. Store protective clothing separately from personal clothing. Launder protective clothing after each use. Shower with soap and water. Wear only clean clothes when leaving job. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Personal clothing worn during mixing/loading, application, repair and cleaning of application equipment, disposal of pesticide, and early reentry into treated fields must be stored and laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and equipment heavily contaminated or drenched with parathion must be destroyed according to state and local regulations.

HEAVY CONTAMINATED OR DRENCHED CLOTHING CANNOT BE ADEQUATELY DECONTAMINATED. Respirators should be cleaned and cartridges replaced according to instructions included with respirators. Replace gloves frequently.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds in treated areas may be killed. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, marshes, bays, and estuaries). Run-off and drift from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in adjacent aquatic sites. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash waters.

This product is extremely toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

CONTAMINATION STATEMENT

Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

RE-ENTRY STATEMENT

Re-entry into treated fields before expiration of the re-entry interval specified below is prohibited, unless the protective clothing and equipment specified on this label are used.

CROP

Table with 2 columns: Crop, Re-Entry Level. Crops listed: citrus, grapes, apples, peaches, corn, olives, tree fruits, tree nuts, cotton and all other crops.

STATES

Table with 2 columns: State, Re-Entry Level. States listed: CA, AZ, NV, NM, OK, TX, UT.

Written or oral warnings must be given to workers who are expected to be in a treated area or in an area about to be treated with this product. In case of accidental exposure, follow instructions under Statement of Practical Treatment section.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Do not allow unauthorized persons access to storage area. If bag is broken, place bag and contents into sealed overpack container. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or residue is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
