Your Application Dated April 15, 1993

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable provided that your:

Make the product labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended label:

1. Revise the label statement prohibiting use on sugarcane in Louisiana to include, or formulate into any which allows further formulation into a product labeled for use on sugarcane in Louisiana.

2. In your directions for use delete the crops barley, dry beans, dry beans (seed), snap beans, apricots, clover, clover-grass mixture, oats, pasture grasses, field peas, soybeans, spinach and wheat. These uses are not being supported for reregistration.

Submit five copies of final printed labeling before you release this product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED, call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED, remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF IN EYES, flush eyes with plenty of clear water for at least 15 minutes, and get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin immediately with soap and warm water.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

ANTIDOTE- Administer atropine sulfate in large therapeutic doses. Repeat as necessary to the point of tolerance. 2-PAM is also antidotal, and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. Azinphos-methyl inhibits cholinesterase, resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system, the parasympathetic nervous system and the somatic motor nerves. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema, which may develop in serious cases of poisoning even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.
