STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration as indicated.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of clear water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin immediately with soap and warm water.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: ANTIDOTE—Administer atropine sulfate in large therapeutic doses. Repeat as necessary to the point of tolerance. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. Azinphos-methyl inhibits cholinesterase, resulting in stimulation of the central nervous systems, the parasympathetic nervous system and the somatic motor nerves. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema which may develop in serious cases of poisoning even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.
