- 3) Per the acute toxicity review, the following "IF INHALED" statements must be added to the first aid statements currently on the label:

"IF INHALED:

Move person to fresh air.

If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferable mouth-to-mouth if possible.

Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice."

- 4) Per the acute toxicity review, the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals must be revised to read:

"CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Harmful if inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing dust."
