2. Within the NOTICE OF CONDITIONS OF SALE AND WARRANTY AND LIABILITY LIMITATIONS section of the label, revise the sentence "*BUYER'S OR USER'S EXCLUSIVE REMEDY AND GOWAN ...*" to read "*TO THE EXTENT ALLOWED BY APPLICABLE LAW, BUYER'S OR USER'S EXCLUSIVE REMEDY AND GOWAN...*"
