N-Methyl Carbamate

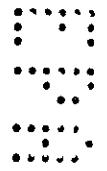

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling. Special attention should be given to treating areas around flower beds, under greenhouse benches and around building foundations.
