In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Decision (RED) for Methidathion, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Generic data requirements that have been identified in the RED as confirmatory data for the active ingredient contained in the subject product will continue to be tracked and assessed in the Agency's continual reassessment of pesticides.

The labeling for the subject product submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided you submit one (1) copy of the final printed label incorporating the following corrections before you release the product for shipment. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this Notice must bear the new revised label.

Reregistration of the subject product is subject to submittal and review of confirmatory data specified in Section V of the Interim Reregistration Eligibility Decision dated August 9, 2002 for methidathion.

- 1. In the Storage and Disposal statement, move the following text from the first paragraph to the subheading PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: "Pesticide wastes may be acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of such wastes is a violation of Federal law."
- 2. Revise the warranty statements titled "Notice of Conditions of Sale and Warranty and Liability Limitations" as specified below.

Add the phrase "to the extent consistent with applicable law," to the beginning of second sentence in the third paragraph.

- 3. Provide Establishment Number on the front panel.
- 4. We have noticed this product has the same name as Syngenta's Methidathion Technical, EPA Registration Number 100-530. We suggest that you confer with Syngenta and one of you should change the product name.

Submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Methidathion is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal and should be given as early poisoning symptoms appear. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. If swallowed, lavage stomach taking care to avoid aspiration of stomach contents into lungs. Instill 30-50 gm. slurry of activated charcoal in water into the stomach after lavage.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER-POISON

Fatal if inhaled. Fatal if swallowed. Fate if absorbed through the skin. Corrosive. Causes skin burns. Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing.
