FIRST AID

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GENERAL INFORMATION

Confuse-OLR is intended for the control of the omnivorous leafroller (*Platynota stultana*) by disrupting the mating of adult moths on crops where this pest is a problem. Confuse-OLR reduces pest populations by delaying and eliminating mating of the target species. This product is a biodegradable, food grade product consisting of a paraffin emulsion and the specific insect pheromone.

RECOMMENDED APPLICATION

Apply Confuse-OLR early in the season or immediately after the first moth is detected in pheromone traps. Wash hands after application. Do not handle other types of insect lures before or after lure placement without thoroughly washing hands. Monitor treatments carefully, especially for secondary pests.

At the 200 gram rate, it is suggested that 133 deposits of 1.5 grams be evenly placed through an acre. Re-apply Confuse-OLR as needed, based on local conditions, monitoring results, and field scouting. |

Several types of application devices are acceptable for dispensing this product in the field, e.g. forestry paint marking guns, etc. The applicator in charge of field applications will instruct as to the number of deposits per vine and the number of vines per acre necessary to treat to acquire the desired dosage per acre of the active ingredient. | | | |
