Dear Ms. Smith:

The proposed labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable under FIFRA § 3(c)(5) provided that you submit two copies of your final printed label before you release the product for shipment.
