Lemons (Arizona Only)	0.5 to 1.25 lbs per acre	Apply 0.5 to 1.25 lbs. of Carzol SP per acre as outside coverage spray when thrips appear. For aerial applications, use a minimum of 10 gallons of water per acre.
	 Do not apply more than 1.25 lbs. of Carzol SP per acre in one crop season. Do not apply within 60 days of harvest
