Dear Ms Smith:

The supplemental labeling referred to above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. You have previously agreed to satisfy the following data requirement in accordance with 40 CFR Part 158:
  - o Estuarine/marine invertebrate life-cycle study (Guideline 72-4(b) / 850.1350). You will submit the data by June 30, 2010.
2. You will submit the following generic data, required by the revised 40 CFR Part 158 rule that became effective on December 26, 2007, within 2 years of the date of this letter (December 2011):
  - o Acute and Subchronic neurotoxicity studies (Guideline 870.6200).
  - o Immunotoxicity study (Guideline 870.7800)

*Please note that after December 2009, applications or requests submitted to the Agency which lack these generic data or an adequate justification as to why the data are not needed, may be considered to be incomplete and returned to the applicant with no further action by the Agency.*

3. At your next label printing, or within eighteen (18) months, whichever comes first, you must incorporate this supplemental labeling into the main product labeling.
4. You will submit production information (pounds or gallons produced) for this product for the fiscal year in which the added uses are conditionally registered, in accordance with FIFRA Section 29. The fiscal year begins October 1 and ends September 30. The production information will be submitted to the Agency no later than November 15 following the end of the preceding fiscal year. 
5. You will make the following label changes:

- a) Under "Crop/Potatoes" add "(Oregon, Washington, and Idaho only)".

You should note that if you fail to satisfy any of the conditions imposed on this registration, e.g., you fail to submit the required data by the specified deadlines or the data submitted were not generated in accordance with applicable test guidelines, EPA may issue notice to cancel this use under FIFRA 6(e).

### GENERAL INFORMATION

Onager controls mites through its activity on eggs and immature stages. Onager does not kill adult mites although treated females will fail to lay viable eggs while in contact with treated foliage. Onager is not systemic and thorough coverage of leaf surfaces is necessary for effective control. Use higher rates on moderate to high mite infestations, dense foliage, or for extended residual control.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
- All applicable restrictions, precautions, worker protection standard requirements, and directions for use on the EPA label must be followed.
- This labeling should be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.
