Your Application Dated July 15, 1988

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comment listed below.

- Delete "water and harborage" from the first sentence under "Selection of Treatment Areas."

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Submit efficacy data showing that each distinct new formulation is acceptable to target rodents. Protocols 1.203 and 1.204 may be used for these tests. Tests must be run for each different bait form (meal, block, large pellet, small pellet) for which you intend to change dyes. For each test, indicate the specific bait (composition and product form) used and identify, by Registration Number, all ICI products which contain the specific bait tested. The test results are due 9 months from the date of this letter.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product without the labeling.

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** For control of mice in homes, industrial buildings and commercial buildings. For indoor use only. Treat bait boxes or in locations not accessible to humans. Do not place bait in areas where the surfaces that come in direct contact with humans.

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREA:** Wherever possible, determine and eliminate the source of infestation. Contain the bait. Generally, these are inside burrows, in corners and concealed locations where rodents or their signs are present.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS**  
**Household and Roof Bats**

Apply 4 to 16 ounces of bait (up to 2 ounces) in bait stations. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of bait until activity ceases.

**House Mice**  
 Apply 1/4 to 1/2 ounce of bait at 10 to 15 bait stations (up to 2 ounces) in bait stations. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of bait until activity ceases.

**Rats & Mice**  
 Replace contaminated or spoiled bait. Remove dead animals and unconsumed bait. Where continuous source of infestation exists, maintain bait stations and replenish bait as needed.

Controls resistant Norway Rats. Rodents may consume a lethal dose in one feeding with first dead rodents appearing four or five days after treatment begins.

Vitamin K<sub>1</sub> is antidotal at doses of 10 to 20 mg.
