STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.



- Control of Norway rats, roof rats, and house mice in and around homes, industrial, commercial, and agricultural buildings, public buildings, similar man-made structures, sewers, and in and around transport vehicles (boats, ships, trains) and related port or terminal buildings;
