APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

Norway and Roof Rats:

Apply 4 to 16 ounces of bait (usually at intervals of 8 to 16 feet) to fresh bait for 10 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.

Apply 1/2 to 1 ounce of bait at intervals of 8 to 16 feet to be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Mouse signs of mouse activity cease.

Rats & Mice:

Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately according to "Disposal" paragraph. To prevent as possible if reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment to establish permanent bait stations and replenish.
