DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply AMBUSH to cotton as shown in the chart below, using sufficient spray TO OBTAIN FULL COVERAGE OF FOLIAGE. The higher rates of AMBUSH (0.15 to 0.2 lbs ai/acre) may be required under conditions of heavy lepidopterous worm infestation. AMBUSH aids in the reduction of lepidopterous egg hatch by contact action. Timing and frequency of spraying should be based upon insect populations reaching local economic thresholds. Apply as required by scouting reports, usually at intervals of 5 to 7 days. For control of boll weevils spray on a 3 to 5 day schedule or as needed. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

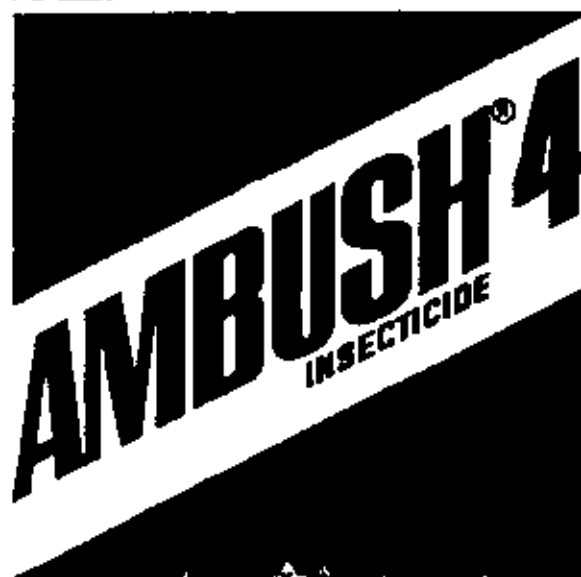
