DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply AAMERON in pattern as shown in the chart below, using sufficient spray to obtain full coverage of foliage. The highest rate of AAMERON (8.15 to 8.2 lbs active) may be required under conditions of heavy lepidopteran worm infestation. AAMERON acts in the reduction of lepidopteran egg hatch by contact action. Timing and frequency of spraying should be based upon insect populations reaching local economic thresholds. Apply as required by existing reports, usually at intervals of 5 to 7 days. For control of boll worms spray on a 3 to 5 day schedule or as needed. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

Do not graze livestock in treated areas.
Do not apply more than 6 pints per acre per season (2 lbs a/Acre).
Do not plant any crop or crop rotation within 60 days after last application. Any crop may be planted if it is not harvested or grazed.
