



Make sure spray solution stays mixed, especially in large holding tanks. Apply the spray solution as a coarse, uniform, low pressure spray in order to minimize drift. Shield nozzle if necessary.

Apply the specified amount of ACTELLIC 5E in 5 gallons of water or 3-5 gallons of at least twice refined soybean oil to each 30 tons (60,000 pounds) of grain according to the following rates:




