TALON/STC BAITERS ARE USED FOR THE CONTROL OF HOUSE MICE IN AND AROUND HOMES, SCHOOLS, HOTELS, HOSPITALS, RESTAURANTS, INDUSTRIAL AND PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND SIMILAR STRUCTURES.

This product is specifically designed for use in areas where mice have been seen and that are in proximity to places that children, pets, and wildlife may frequent or where food is stored or prepared.

TALON/STC Baiters are a ready-to-use, refillable product that is contained in a "tamper-resistant" bait station, and may be placed in areas accessible to children, pets, or wildlife or where food is prepared or stored. The baiter must be properly secured when used in these areas.

The TALON/STC Baiter may only be refilled with TALON/STC Bait Blocks. Save the Baiter with outer carton for possible future use.

See "Hints for Proper Usage" for instruction on how to secure baiter. Place one TALON/STC Baiter every 8-12 feet where mouse activity is noticed. Observe bait level frequently and maintain uninterrupted supply of TALON/STC Baits for at least 20 days or longer if necessary. Unconsumed bait may be left in baiter, but replace spoiled or contaminated bait immediately. Dispose of dead mice and unconsumed bait properly (See "Disposal" statement). To prevent reinfestation, eliminate food, water, and harborage as much as possible.

HAZARDS TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND HUMANS

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN OR VETERINARIAN

This product may reduce the clotting ability of blood and cause hemorrhaging. If poisoning occurs, intramuscular and oral administration of Vitamin K_1 are indicated, as in poisoning from overdose of bishydroxy coumarin. For human cases, Vitamin K_1 is antidotal at doses of 10 to 20 mg (not mg/kg). For animal cases, Vitamin K_1 is antidotal at 2-5 mg/kg. TALON/STC BAITER

This ready-to-use, TALON/STC Baiter contains 2 rodenticide bait blocks. To refill baiter, see "REFILL" directions.

- Select an area where mouse droppings or activities are observed. Generally, these areas are along walls, near gnawed openings, in corners and concealed places.
- 2. Remove base plate from the package. Apply the enclosed double-sided tape to the bottom of the plate in area indicated, removing paper backing from tape. Place plate on a clean, dry, grease-free surface directly next to wall by pressing the plate down firmly against floor, making sure plate arrows point towards the wall.
- 3. With the FRONT of the baiter facing away from the wall, slide baiter into and along the raised tabs of the base plate until the baiter is centered on the plate. Arrow on base plate and on baiter should now be aligned and the baiter tunnels alongside the wall. Insure that baiter is firmly attached to the floor. The TALON/STC Baiter is now ready to use.
- 4. Hints for Proper Usage: The TALON/STC Baiter is designed to adhere to smooth flat surfaces such as wood, asphalt tiles, flat concrete. Test the TALON/STC Baiter to insure that it holds securely. For rough or unsuitable surfaces, attach the baiter directly to the floor with screws using key hole slots in bottom of baiter. In areas accessible to children, pets and wildlife, the TALON/STC Baiter must be secured to the floor. TO REMOVE TAPED PLATE FROM FLOOR: Slide a putty knife or similar object between the base plate and the top of the adhesive tapes. Excess tape can then be rolled off with finger. Do not pry or use excessive force, as this can mar or damage the floor surface.

BACK PANEL (Con't.)

TO REFILL BAITER:

- 1. When a bait compartment is empty, refill using only TALON/STC Bait Blocks. Slide the baiter in either direction to release it from base plate.
- 2. To open baiter and expose bait, use a key or similar object to push in the 2 locking tabs at rear of baiter while separating tunnels with fingers. Lift off top of baiter.
- 3. Remove any excess bait (see "Disposal" statement). Press a new TALON/STC Bait Block into the bait compartment, fitting block hole over post in center of compartment.
- 4. Reassemble baiter by fitting front tabs of baiter top into front slots of baiter bottom. Press baiter top down until rear locking tabs snap into place. INSURE THAT BAITER TOP AND BOTTOM ARE SECURELY LOCKED TOGETHER.
- 5. Slide TALON/STC Baiter back into floor-mounted plate. The refilled baiter is ready to use.
