Food Handling: Establishments handling food in which food is held, processed, prepared or served: DEMON EC must be applied to crack and crevice treatment in cracks, holes or through which insects (to rodents), entries and ventilators, offices, boiler rooms, garbage-room, closets and...

Food Areas: DEMON EC is not to be used in food areas of food processing plants, food is commonly prepared or processed, food is served, such as dining rooms, etc. Food is prepared or held in the form of food would be served during treatment or. Exposed food should be covered or removed areas for receiving, storage, packing, processing, etc. with water. DEMON EC is not to be used in food areas.

Note: Do not use water hose sprays of buildings, porch beams, window frames, or other possible shock hazard. Lat surfaces dry before contact surfaces. Protect aquariums from spray and screen with water and delay maintenance. Do not use this product with oil.

Cockroaches, Spiders, Crickets, Silverfish and Firebrats: Apply as a narrow low pressure spray to areas where these pests hide, such as baseboards, corners, storage areas, closets, around water pipes, doors and windows, attics and eaves, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks, furnaces and stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers and similar areas. Pay particular attention to cracks and crevices. Also see OUTDOOR USE.

Ants: Apply to any trails, around doors and windows and other places where ants may be found. Refer to barrier treatment directions to prevent infestation. Also see OUTDOOR USE.

Wasp and Bees: Application to nests should be made late in evening when insects are all near. Thoroughly spray nest and entrance and surrounding areas where insects alight. Also see OUTDOOR USE. **Beetles, Pillbugs, Silverfish and Crickets:** Apply around doors and windows and other places where these pests may be found or where they may enter premises. Spray baseboards, storage areas and other locations. Refer to barrier treatment directions to prevent infestation. Also see OUTDOOR USE.
