The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

The Acute Inhalation study submitted is acceptable and has been made a part of the record for this product. Our review indicates that the product should be placed in Toxicity Category II due to the inhalation route of exposure.

As a result of this categorization, on the product label after "Causes Substantial But Temporary Eye Injury" add "Do not breathe vapors. Wear a mask or respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health."

With respect to your question regarding issuance of an unconditional registration, since the subject product is formulated into products for use on cotton which is a conditional registration the unconditional status of the subject product and end-use product will be addressed after all outstanding data is submitted and accepted.
