The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted subject to the comments reflected on the enclosed sheet. A copy of your proposed labeling stamped "ACCEPTED WITH COMMENTS" is enclosed.

WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. Any other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application but not directly related to compliance with the WPS have not been reviewed or accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. If your product is currently suspended, the acceptance of this labeling amendment does not affect the suspension in any way.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO NEXT:

By the next label printing make all the specified changes to your labeling. Send to EPA one (1) copy of the final printed labeling:

- BEFORE selling or distributing any product bearing the final printed labeling AND
- WITHIN one year from date of this acceptance.

The following specific comments pertain to your WPS labeling submission concerning the product cited above:

User Safety Recommendations must either be placed in a box or printed on the label in a contrasting color from surrounding text.

The Agricultural Use Requirements section must be located in a clearly separate box on the product labeling -- with lines or other graphic indicators (such as contrasting color) to separate the section from the surrounding text.

The following statement on your proposed label is not required for this product: "Notify workers of the application by warning them orally and by posting warning signs at entrances to treated areas." Delete it from the Agricultural Use Requirements box.

Delete the crossed-out statements on your proposed label. They are redundant statements or phrases.


ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Drift and runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not clean equipment or dispose of equipment washwaters in a manner that will contaminate water resources.

In the event that treated seed pieces are spilled and can not be salvaged, completely cover them with soil.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this tabel about personal protective equipment (PPE) notification to workers, and restricted entry interval. The requirements in this box only apply to uses of this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.

Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 4 days.


Fieldworkers and harvesters must wear chemical resistant gloves. Leather or fabrio gloves are not acceptable.

During application only, from a tractor with a completely-enclosed cab or I rom an aircraft with an enclosed cockpit, a long sleeved shirt and long legged pants must be vom. Chemically resistant gloves must be available in the cab or cockpit and worm while ex ting.

Only the applicator is permitted to be in the greenhouse during application of CAPTAN. Open vents to greenhouse during application and for at least 1 hour after application.

Workers planting in CAPTAN treated soil must wear chemical resistant gloves:

AFTER-WORK: Take off all clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and protective equipment heavily contaminated or drenched with CAPTAN must be destroyed according to state and local regulations.

- Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers

- Do not allow persons to enter treated areas within 4 days following application unless a long-sleeved shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands and feet and chemically resistant gloves are worn: Conspicuously post reentry information as site of application.
- Certain states may require more restrictive reentry intervals for various erops treated with this product. Consult your State Department of Agriculture for further information.

RECOMMENDATIONS

POTATO SEED PIECE TREATMENT: Damping off, seed rot fungi, brown eye disease, verticillium wilt -- Apply at the rate of 11½ ounces per bushel cut seed pieces (18 ounces to 100 pounds of cut seed pieces). Apply in convenient container or by duster attachment over belt. Coat each seed piece evenly with a light film of dust. Treat pieces within 6 hours after cutting. If planting is delayed, store treated seed pieces in open crates for two days before bagging. Do not use excess seed pieces for food or feed purposes.

This product is not for commercial seed treatment. Treat only the amount of seed that is to be planted. Treated seed that is not planted must be destroyed in accordance with Federal and State regulations.

SOIL AND GREENHOUSE BENCH TREATMENT: For damping - off and root rot diseases of seedlings and transplants of roses, other shrubs, flowers and lawn seedbeds. Apply 2¼ pounds per 1,000 square feet (98 pounds per acre). Work into upper 3 or 4 inches of soil before planting.

Only the applicator is permitted to be in the greenhouse during application of CAPTAN. Open vents to greenhouse during application and for at least 1 hour after application.

Workers planting in CAPTAN-treated soil must wear chemical resistant gloves-

ORNAMENTALS: ROSES - (black spot), CARNATION - (rust, leaf spot), CHRYSANTHEMUM - (flower blight), -- Apply thoroughly prior to or atifirst sign of disease. Repeat applications at 7 to 10 day intervals. Shorten interval during periods of frequent rain and heavy dews.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Protect from excessive heat. Store in a cool, dry place.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
