Your Application Dated February 18, 1993

Submitting Eye Irritation Study

The labeling referred to above, submitted in accordance with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable with the following provisions:

- In the "Statement of Practical Treatment" replace the "If swallowed" statement with the following: "Get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol." This is the correct statement for products whose toxicity category is "II" for eye irritation.
- 2. A "Note to Physician" is required for this product because it is classified as toxicity category II for eye irritation. It should be located in close proximity to the "Statement of Practical Treatment", appearing below the last statement of practical treatment. Include the following statement on the labeling: "Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."
- 3. In the "Precautionary Statements" section, revise the second sentence of the statement so that it reads, "Causes substantial but temporary eye injury."
