STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

First Aid

Ingestion

Immediately flush eyes with large amounts of running water for at least 15 minutes. Hold eyelids apart during flushing to ensure rinsing of the entire surface of the eye and lids with water. Get medical attention immediately.

Skin Contact

Flush affected areas with plenty of water for several minutes. Remove and clean contaminated clothing and shoes. Seek medical attention if irritation occurs.

Inhalation

If inhaled, remove to fresh air. Seek medical attention if respiratory irritation occurs or if breathing becomes difficult.
