Statement of Practical Treatment

A known herbicide which is a selective herbicide for the control of weeds in corn. The treatment is required to be applied to the soil in the row of corn.

If swallowed: Wash mouth with water. Do not induce vomiting. Get medical attention immediately.

For skin contact: Wash with plenty of water. Wash hands and exposed areas with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

For eye contact: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

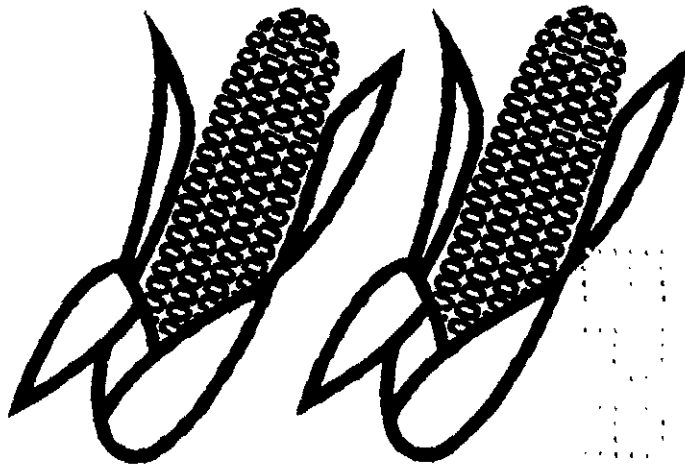
If inhaled: Remove to fresh air. Wash nose and throat with water. Get medical attention if breathing becomes difficult.
