STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FIRST AID:

CALL A POISON CONTROL CENTER OR PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY
If a known exposure occurs or is suspected, immediately start the procedures given below and
contact a Poison Control Center, physician or the nearest hospital.

NOTE: Be sure to advise the person contacted that the product is a weak cholinesterase inhibitor in experimental animals. Describe the type and extent of exposure, the victim's symptoms, and follow the advice given.

NOTE TO MEDICAL PERSONNEL: If cholinesterase inhibition is suspected, atropine by injection is antidotal. It has not been determined if pralidoxime chloride (2-PAM, protopam) is antidotal for the product.

IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air. Seek medical attention if respiratory irritation occurs or breathing becomes difficult.
