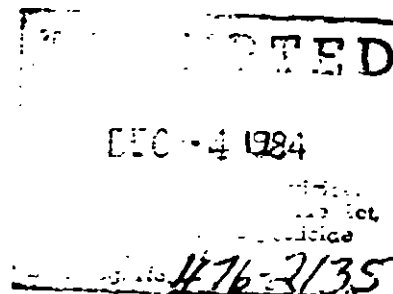

FIRST AID:

If a known exposure occurs or is suspected, do not wait for symptoms to develop. Immediately initiate the procedures recommended below. Simultaneously contact a physician, the nearest hospital, or the nearest Poison Control Center. Describe the situation and follow the advice given. For additional information, call collect, day or night, Pesticide Team Safety Network (800) 424-9300 or Stauffer Chemical Company (203) 226-6602.

If swallowed, immediately dilute the swallowed material by giving large quantities of water and induce vomiting by gagging the victim with a finger placed on the back of the victim's tongue. Give fluids until vomitus is clear. If victim is unconscious or convulsing, do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth. Call a physician.

For eye contact, hold eyelids apart and flush with large amounts running water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

For skin contact, flush with large amounts of running water for 15 minutes. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes. Get medical attention if skin irritation occurs. Wash clothing before reuse.

If inhaled, remove to fresh air. Get medical attention if respiratory irritation occurs or if breathing is difficult.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities.

Alternate container disposal statement for tank cars:

CONTAINER HANDLING: After emptying, replace valve caps and tightly re-bolt top hatch of tank car. Follow Stauffer's instructions for return of empty tank car.

SPILL HANDLING: Absorb spilled material on an inert absorbent such as clay. Sweep up absorbent and dispose of in a suitable chemical waste container. Wash spill area with a detergent water slurry. Spread absorbent on the slurried liquid and absorbent material into chemical waste container. Flush spill area with water; observe environmental precautions.
