DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

POTATOES

Lay-By: Apply and incorporate 3-1/2 to 7 pints EPTAM 7-E per acre after potato plants have emerged from the soil. Do not apply within 45 days of harvest.

- Apply EPTAM 7-E as a directed spray to the soil and incorporate with a cultivator to a depth of 2-3 inches.

OR

- Surface apply EPTAM 7-E after potato plants have emerged from the soil. The soil surface should be dry (at least 1/2 inch deep) and free from dew and incidental moisture. Sprinkler incorporate using 1/2 to 3/4 inch of water within 36 hours following application. The application and incorporation must be done within five days after the last tillage operation, since poor results will occur if weeds have germinated.

OR


- Irrigation: Meter 3-1/2 to 7 pints EPTAM 7-E per acre into the irrigation water after clean cultivation. Do not apply within 45 days of harvest.

All applicable directions, restrictions and precautions on the EPA-registered label are to be followed.

This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.
