The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling change(s) below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The labeling must bear the following protective clothing statement:

"Mixer/loaders must wear goggles or a face shield, chemical-resistant apron, long-sleeved shirt and long pants or coveralls, and mid-forearm to elbow length chemical-resistant gloves when mixing, loading, or otherwise handling the concentrate."

2. The directions for use must include the following statement:

"Formulators using this product are responsible for EPA registrations for their formulated product(s)."

3. Add the statement:

"Imidan® Technical Organophosphorous Insecticide is intended for formulation into end-use product for the following acceptable use pattern (List Uses).

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Immediately give large amounts of water and induce vomiting by gagging the victim with a finger placed on the back of the victim's tongue. Give fluids until vomitus is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen, preferably with a physician's advice.

If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing and shoes and immediately wash affected areas with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation occurs. Wash clothing that is reusable.

If in eyes: Hold eyelids apart and flush eyes with large amounts of running water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician immediately.
