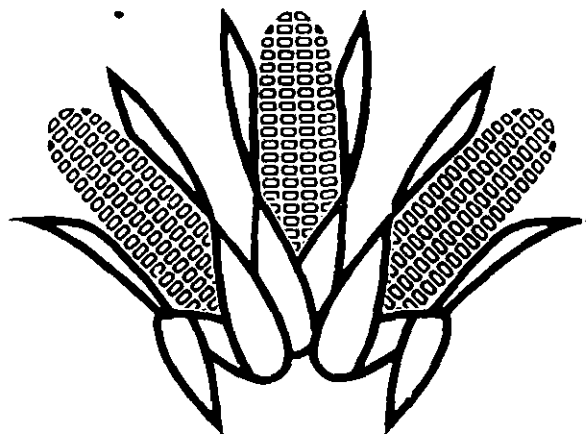

Statement of Practical Treatment

FIRST AID

Immediately start the procedures below. If further treatment is required, contact a Poison Center, a physician, or the nearest hospital.

If swallowed:

Immediately give several glasses of water but do not induce vomiting. If vomiting does occur, give fluids again. Have a physician determine if condition of patient will permit induction of vomiting or evacuation of stomach. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious or comatose person.

For eye contact:

Immediately flush eyes with large amounts of running water for at least 15 minutes. Hold eyelids apart to ensure rinsing of the entire surface of the eye and lids with water. Get medical attention immediately.

For skin contact:

Flush all affected areas with plenty of water for several minutes. Remove and clean contaminated clothing and shoes. Seek medical attention if irritation occurs.

If inhaled:

Remove to fresh air. Seek medical attention if respiratory irritation occurs or if breathing becomes difficult.
