(Application should be delayed until the desired number of daughter plants have become established. Do not apply from bloom through harvest.)

WHEN TO USE THIS PRODUCT

DEVRINOL 2-G Ornamental should be used before weeds germinate. It will not control established weeds.

Application can be made anytime of the year to v_ed-free soil. Fall and winter applications will provide excellent weed control the following spring and summer.

In containers, apply after setting and watering the plants.

HOW TO USE THIS PRODUCT

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply this product as specified on this label.

DEVRINOL 2-G Ornamental should be spread evenly on the soil surface using a shaker can or granular herbicide applicator.

Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated.

When weed infestation is heavy or when broadleaves are the or-mary weeds, use one pound on 145 squire feet (6.9 lbs./1,000 sq. ft.). For annual grassy weeds or when weed infestation is light, use one pound on 218 square feet (4.6 lbs./1,000 sq. ft.).

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DEVRINOL 2-G Ornamental should be incorporated evenly into the soil using a hand cultivator to a depth of l-2 inches or irrigation or natural moisture (rainfall or snow) (l-2 inches within 2-3 days) for optimum results.

For weed control in dichondra, apply at the time of seeding or to establish dichondra including dichondra sod. Irrigate with a minimum of one inch of water.

RECOMMENDATIONS: TURF GRASS (FOR USE ON WARM SEASON GRASSES ONLY)

DEVRINOL 2-G is recommended for annual bluegrass, crabgrass and goosegrass control in the following established turf grasses: bahia, bermudagrass, centipede, St. Augustine and fescue.

TIMING OF APPLICATION:

For control of crabgrass and goosegrass, apply DEVRINOL 2-G at the recommended rate. Application should be made 2-3 weeks prior to weed emergence. DEVRINOL 2-G should be applied with a gravity flow drop spreader or a cyclone type spreader. A more uniform application can be made by spreading half the required amount over the area to be treated, then applying the remainder at right angles.

DEVRINOL 2-G requires a minimum of one half (1/2) inch of rainfall or irrigation 2-3 days after application for adequate control. If irrigation methods are not available, the timing of the application of DEVRINOL 2-G should be moved back several weeks to allow for some rainfall between application and weed germination.

RATES OF APPLICATION:

FOR CRABGRASS CONTROL: Apply 100 to 150 lbs. of DEVRINOL 2-G uniformly per (2.25-3.38* lbs per 1,000 sq. ft.). Use the higher rate when applying before January 1 (not applicable north of South Carolina or when weed infestation is expected to be heavy).

FOR GOOSEGRASS CONTROL: Apply 100 to 150 lbs. of DEVRINOL 2-G per acre (2.25-3.38 lbs per 1,000 sq. ft.). Goosegrass usually starts to germinate 6 to 7 weeks after the start of crabgrass germination.

SPLIT APPLICATION FOR CRABGRASS AND GOOSEGRASS CONTROL: When both of these weeds are to be controlled, apply 100 lbs. of DEVRINOL 2-G spread uniformly per acre (2.25 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) for crabgrass and another 100 lbs. of DEVRINOL 2-G per acre for goosegrass. Apply 8-10 weeks apart. Timing should be adjusted to the germination of weeds in your area. Split applications give longer and better weed control than one application.



FOR ANNUAL BLUEGRASS (POA ANNUA) CONTROL: Annual bluegrass is a winter annual in most of the warm season turf regions; therefore, application of DEVRINOL 2-G should be made in the fall before the annual bluegrass germinates. Apply 100-150 lbs of DEVRINOL 2-G per acre (2.25-3.38 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.).

RESEEDING. Do not reseed or overseed within six months after application.

*Where a rate range is given, use the higher rate when weed infestation is expected to be heavy.
