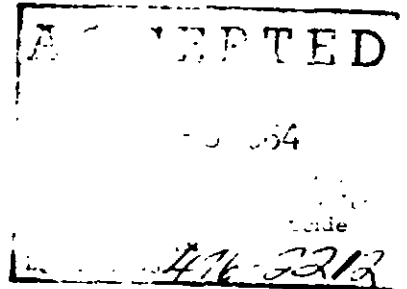

Immediately flush the eyes with plenty of running water for at least 15 minutes. Hold the eyelids apart during the flushing to ensure rinsing of the entire surface of the eye and lids with water. Get medical attention immediately.
