The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. If the Precautionary Statements section does not appear on the front panel of the labeling when printed, add a referral statement similar to the following:

See side panel for additional precautionary statements.

b. Update the Environmental Hazards section to read as follows:

Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

The alternate formula dated October 17, 1997 is acceptable and has been included in the files for this product.

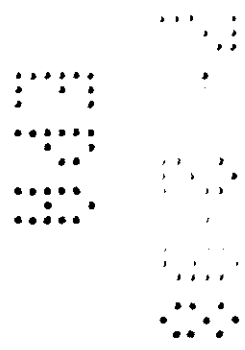

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FIRST AID:

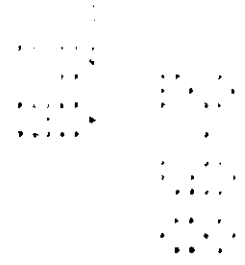
This product is intended for further manufacturing of pesticides only. All formulators are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

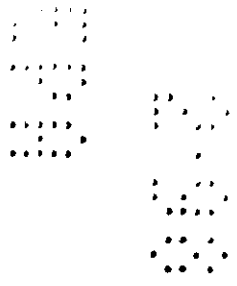
PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
