3. With respect to the product chemistry data submitted,

a. Provide a copy of Analytical Method Number WRC 90-546 which outlines determination of the certified limits for the active ingredient.

b. The accelerated storage stability data at 10°C, 25°C, 40°C, and 50°C for 4 and 8 weeks are acceptable on an interim basis. One year storage stability data at ambient warehouse conditions must be received by EPA within 15 months after the date of this registration.

4. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For residual pest control in and on buildings and structures and their immediate surroundings and on modes of transport. Permitted areas of use include but are not limited to industrial buildings, houses, apartment buildings, laboratories, buses, greenhouses, stores, warehouses, vessels, railcars, trucks, trailers, aircraft, schools, nursing homes, hospitals, restaurants, hotels and food manufacturing, processing and servicing establishments.

COMMODORE 10WP insecticide is intended for dilution with water for spray application. Do not use strainers finer than 50 mesh size. Fill sprayer with the desired volume of water and add COMMODORE 10WP insecticide. Close and shake before use in order to insure proper suspension of the wettable powder. Shake or reagituate sprayer before use if spraying is interrupted. Make up only as required, COMMODORE 10WP can be reapplied at 21 day intervals if necessary.

1. **ANTS:** Apply to any trails, around doors and windows and other places where ants may be found. Apply barrier treatments to prevent infestation as directed below, also see Outdoor Use.
2. **COCKROACHES, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, AND FIREBRATS:** Apply as a coarse, low pressure spray to areas where these pests hide, such as baseboards, corners, storage areas, closets, around water pipes, doors and windows, attics and eaves, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks, furnaces, and stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers and similar areas. Pay particular attention to cracks and crevices; also see OUTDOOR USE.
3. **FLIES:** Apply directly to walls ceilings, window screens, and other fly resting areas as a residual surface treatment. May be used inside residential buildings as well as in and around carports, garages, and storage sheds. Also see OUTDOOR USE.
4. **PANTRY PESTS** (i.e., Carpet beetle, Confused flour beetle, Cigarette beetle, Lesser grain borer, Red flour beetle, Rice Weevil, and Saw-toothed grain beetle). : Apply to cupboards, shelving and storage areas. Remove all utensils, uncovered foodstuffs (or any having original package opened), shelf paper before spraying. Allow treated surfaces to dry and cover shelves with clean paper before replacing any utensils, foodstuff or other items. Any foodstuff accidentally contaminated with spray solution should be destroyed.
5. **SOWBUGS, PILLBUGS, MILLIPEDES AND CENTIPEDES:** Apply around doors and windows and other places where these pests may be found or where they may enter premises. Spray baseboards, storage areas and other locations. Apply barrier treatments to prevent infestation as described below, also see OUTDOOR USE.



Application Within Food Handling Establishment: (places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served) including, but not limited to, areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing foods, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups) and serving areas. Use as a crack and crevice or spot treatment in and around both food and non-food areas. Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices, using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floor, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment and bases.

Limit individual spot treatments to an area no larger than 20% of the treated surface. Individual spot treatments should not exceed two square feet. Take extreme care that the product is not introduced into the air. Avoid contamination of food and food processing surfaces.

Not for use in USDA meat and poultry plants.

Application within Food Serving Areas: (facilities where foods are served, such as dining rooms):

Apply as a crack and crevice or spot treatment to selective surfaces, such as baseboards, under elements of construction and into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed.)

Application of this product in the Food Areas and/or Food Serving Areas of Food Handling Establishments other than as a spot and/or crack and crevice treatment is not permitted.

OUTDOOR USE: For control of ants, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, millipedes, scorpions, sowbugs, pillbugs, spiders, flies. Apply with either hand or power sprayer as a residual spray to surfaces of buildings, porches, screens, window frames, eaves, patios, lawns, refuse dumps, garages and in other areas where these pests are found.

BARRIER TREATMENTS: To help prevent infestation of building, apply to a band of soil and vegetation 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the building. Also, treat the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where pests are active and may find entrance. Apply as a coarse spray to thoroughly and uniformly wet the band area, using 1 gallon of spray mix per 400 square feet.

NOTE: Do not use water base sprays of COMMODORE 10WP in conduits, motor housings, junction boxes, switch boxes, or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. Let surfaces dry before allowing children and pets to contact surfaces. Protect aquariums from spray mist. Thoroughly wash out sprayer and screen with water and detergent before using COMMODORE 10WP insecticide. Do not use this product with oil.

Do not apply this product in patient rooms or in any rooms while occupied by the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to classrooms when in use.

Do not apply this product to edible crops.



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Prohibitions: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not use empty container.

- ✓ Storage: Mix as needed. Do not store diluted material. Do not store near food or feed. In case of spill on floor or paved surfaces, sweep up and remove to chemical waste area.
- ✓ Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site at an approved waste disposal facility.
