STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

REENTRY STATEMENT

Keep all unprotected persons out of operating areas or vicinity where there may be danger of drift.

Do not allow persons to enter treated areas within 4 days following application unless a long sleeved shirt and long pants or coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands and feet and chemically resistant gloves are worn. Conspicuously post reentry information at site of application.

Certain states may require more restrictive reentry intervals; consult your State Department of Agriculture for further information.

Written or oral warnings regarding use of protective clothing and accidental exposure must be given to workers who are expected to be in treated areas or in areas about to be treated.

DIRECTIONS

Mixers/loaders when mixing and loading this product must wear a long sleeved shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands and feet. Wear chemical resistant gloves, goggles or a face shield and chemically resistant apron.

Fieldworkers and harvesters must wear chemical resistant gloves if entering treated areas within 4 days following application. Leather or fabric gloves are not acceptable.

A dust mask must be worn when mixing and loading this product.

During application only, if from a tractor with a completely enclosed cab or from an aircraft with an enclosed cockpit a long sleeved shirt and long legged pants must be worn. Chemically resistant gloves must be available in the cab or cockpit and worn while exiting.

AFTER WORK: Take off all cloths and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and protective equipment heavily contaminated or drenched with Captan must be destroyed according to state and local regulations.

This product is formulated for application by ground or air equipment.

Do not apply under conditions involving possible drift to food, forage or other plantings that might be damaged or the crops thereof rendered unfit for sale, use or consumption.

COMPATIBILITY: Do not use this product on foliage closely following oil sprays.

ORNAMENTAL CROPS

ROSES, HYDRANGEA: Blight (Botrytis) - Use 30 lbs. per acre. Field: Apply prior to shipment or storage. Stored Areas: Thoroughly dust storage area and all canes and foliage; repeat application during long storage periods.

CHRYSANTHEMUM, GERANIUM, ROSES: Blight (Botrytis) - Use 30 lbs. per acre. Apply at first sign of disease to give even coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals.

GLADIOLUS: Dry Rot (Stromatinia) - Soil - Use 250 lbs. per 14,520 linear feet of furrow. Dust into furrow at planting time, so treated soil surrounds corns. Foliage - Use 30 lbs. per acre, dust thoroughly to insure coverage between spikes. Apply to bunched flower spikes after harvest and before shipment or storage.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE

Keep pesticide in original container. Store in cool, dry place. Protect from excessive heat. Do not store or transport near feed or food. For help with any spill, leak, fire or exposure involving this material, call day or night 1-800-424-9300.
