Application Equipment Preparation

For best results, thoroughly wash out sprayer and screens with water and detergent before using COMMODORE® WP insecticide in water-soluble packets. To avoid sprayer clogging, do not use strainers or screens finer than 50 mesh size.

Mixing Procedures

Each foil envelope of COMMODORE WP insecticide in water-soluble packets contains two water-soluble packets of COMMODORE wettable powder (WP). Because water-soluble packets readily dissolve in the presence of moisture, do not allow them to get wet before adding to the applicator tank. Wear dry gloves when handling the water-soluble packets. Handle with care because excessive handling may cause rupture of the water-soluble packet. Unused water-soluble packets should be stored in the original foil envelope, folded over to minimize exposure to moisture.

COMMODORE WP insecticide in water-soluble packets are intended for dilution with water for applications. For best results, dilution should be achieved if the following steps are taken:

- 1. Fill applicator tank 1/2 with water.
- 2. Add desired COMMODORE WP insecticide water-soluble packets.
- 3. Allow 1-2 minutes for dissolution of water-soluble packets(s).
- 4. Agitate applicator tank.
- 5. Finish filling applicator tank and agitate again before use to ensure satisfactory suspension.

Tank Mixing
