### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FUSION herbicide may be applied for control of emerged annual and perennial grass weeds before, during or after planting or after harvest of soybeans or cotton. FUSION herbicide does not control broadleaf weeds or sedges (nutgrass).

### GENERAL USE PRECAUTIONS

- Tankmixes of FUSION herbicide with other pesticides, liquid fertilizers or other additives except as specified on this label or on approved ZENECA supplemental labels may result in tankmix incompatibility, unsatisfactory performance and/or crop injury.

**SPRAY ADDITIVES:** Only crop oil concentrate, nonionic surfactants and other adjuvants cleared for use on growing crops may be used in spray mixture. Under dry conditions, crop oil concentrate is the preferred adjuvant.

Other Adjuvants - Adjuvants other than COC or NIS may be used providing the product meets the following criteria:

1. Contains only EPA exempt ingredients.
2. Is nonphytotoxic to the target crop.
3. Is compatible in mixture. (May be established through a jar test.)
4. Is supported locally for use with FUSION on the target crop through proven field trials and through university and extension recommendations.

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## DIRECTIONS FOR ANNUAL AND PERENNIAL GRASS WEED CONTROL IN COTTON

### REGION A

FUSION herbicide may be applied in the following states: Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, North Carolina, Oklahoma (east of Interstate 35), South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas (east of Interstate 35).

### REGION B

New Mexico, Oklahoma (West of I-35), and Texas (West of I-35).

### SPECIFIC RESTRICTIONS FOR COTTON

- Do not apply a total of more than 24 oz. of FUSION herbicide per acre per season to cotton.
- Do not apply to cotton after boll set.
- Do not harvest cotton within 90 days of FUSION application.
- Do not graze or harvest for forage or hay.
- Tankmixes with other herbicides for use in cotton are not recommended unless specified on this label or other supplemental labeling.

**Always refer to the EPA registered product container label booklet and follow recommendations concerning rates, target weeds, environmental effects such as drought or weed stress, and use in tankmix with other labeled pesticides.**

**All applicable directions, restrictions and precautions on the EPA-registered label are to be followed.**
