PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: BAQUACIDE 795 Swimming Pool Algicide is cationic. Do not mix with soap or anionic materials. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

SWIMMING POOLS

INITIAL DOSE: Add 1 1/4 fluid ounce BAQUACIDE 795 per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: Add 1 1/4 fluid ounce BAQUACIDE 795 per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

Initial dose is used when filling pool or upon conversion to BAQUACIDE. If pool has visible algae growth, treat with initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or re-appear, repeat this treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added weekly. If high to super saturation of pool has unusually heavy use, add extra maintenance dose as necessary.

Maintenance dose should be added after a heavy or prolonged rainfall.

If make-up water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1/2 fluid ounce BAQUACIDE 795 for each 1000 gallons of fresh make-up water added.

When swimming season is over, add initial dose prior to closing pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

When BAQUACIDE 795 is used as directed, it is effective against Chloroella pyramoidosa (green algae), Phormidium luridum (black algae), Lyngbya rotatorum (blue-green algae), Plectonochloris wrightii (mustard algae) and other swimming pool algae and slime producing microorganisms.

For persistent algae or slime producing microorganism growth, add 3-7 1/2 ounces of BAQUACIDE 795 per 10,000 gallons of pool water into the skimmer with the filter pump running. After one minute, shut off the pump and allow the system to remain off over night. The following day, re-start the filter pump and add 3-7 1/2 ounces of BAQUACIDE 795 to the pool. Run the filter continuously for 24-36 hours, brushing the sides and bottom of the pool frequently.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORE IN ORIGINAL CONTAINERS AND PLACE IN LOCKED STORAGE AREA.

KEEP FROM FREEZING.
