ROTATIONAL CROP RESTRICTIONS

The following rotational crops may be planted after applying FLEXSTAR HL at recommended rates in soybeans:

<u>Crop To Be Planted</u>	<u>Minimum Rotation Interval (Months After Last FLEXSTAR HL Application)</u>
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Small grains such as wheat, barley, rye	4
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Alfalfa, beans & peas, corn*, cotton, peanuts, rice	10
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To avoid crop injury do not plant sunflowers, sugar beets, sorghum** or any other crop within	18
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Do not graze rotated small grain crops or harvest forage or straw for livestock. In the event of a crop loss due to weather conditions soybeans can be replanted.

* Use 18 month minimum rotation interval for sweet corn in the states of Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New York, Rhode Island, Vermont and Region 5.

** Sorghum may be planted back after 10 months in Region 1.

All applicable directions, restrictions and precautions on the EPA-registered label are to be followed.
