Personal Protective Equipment

Applicators and pilots not involved in mixing or loading this product must wear:

- Coverall or long-sleeved shirt, long pants
- Shoes plus socks

Mixers, loaders, flaggers and others coming in contact with this product must wear:

- (a) A long-sleeved shirt and long pants under disposable coveralls made of a synthetic material capable of excluding particles 45 microns or larger in diameter, such as Kleenguard™ OR (b) A cotton coverall or chemical-resistant coverall over a full body cloth suit impregnated with activated charcoal OR (c) applies only to use in California: A chemical-resistant coverall (as specified in the current California Department of Pesticide Regulation molinate Worker Safety Permit Conditions) over long-sleeved shirt and pants.
- Chemical-resistant gloves, such as barrier laminate or butyl rubber ≥14 mils or nitrile rubber ≥14 mils or viton ≥14 mils.
- Chemical-resistant footwear plus socks.
- A respirator with either an organic vapor-removing cartridge with a prefilter approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-23C) or a canister approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-14G).

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning and maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

The above personal protective equipment requirements for mixers and loaders may not be reduced even if a closed mixing and loading system is used. Handler PPE may not be reduced or modified as specified in the Worker Protection Standard for Agricultural Pesticides [40 CFR 170.240 (d) (4-6)] for closed systems.

Refer to container label for Directions for Use and other restrictions and precautions.

This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.
