


- c. Aerobic Aquatic Metabolism with emphasis on degradates tralkoxydim acid (Compound 8), Compound 3 and Compound 17 [Guideline #162-4]
- d. Leaching-Adsorption-Desorption Data for the degradate Compound 3 [Guideline #163-1]
- e. Terrestrial Field Dissipation [Guideline #164-1]
- f. Freshwater Fish LC_{50} for degradate tralkoxydim acid [Guideline #72-1]
- g. Freshwater Invertebrate LC_{50} for degradate tralkoxydim acid [Guideline #72-2]

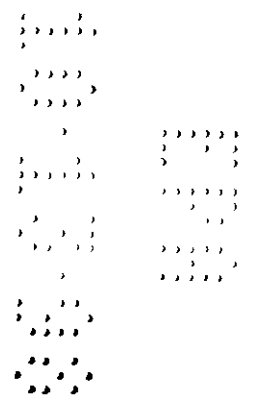

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FIRST AID
