

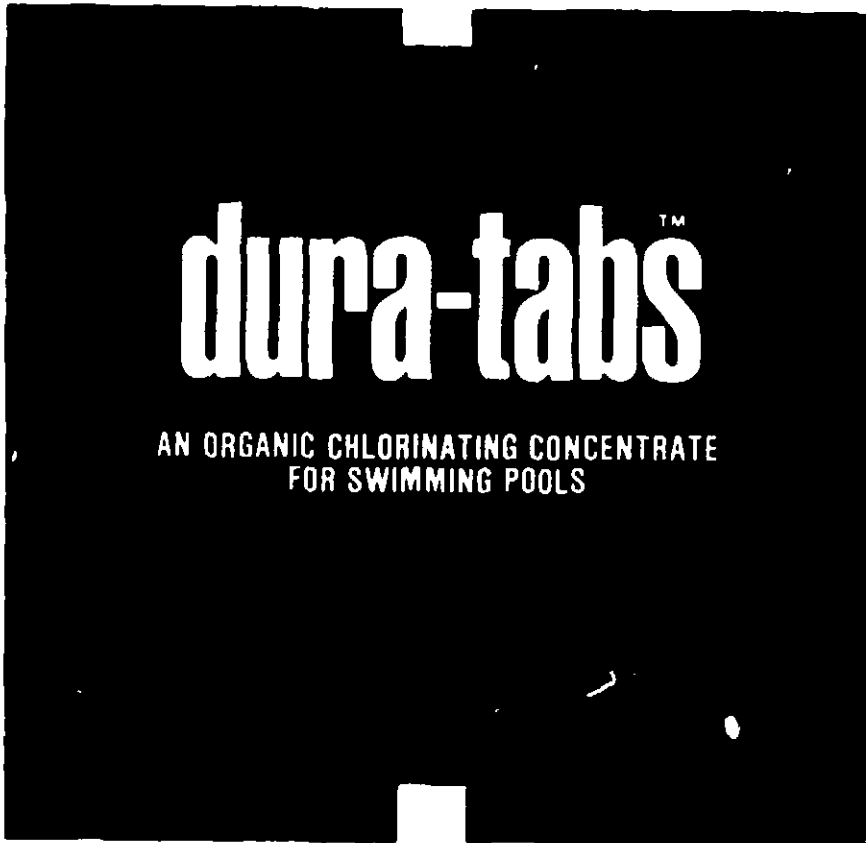

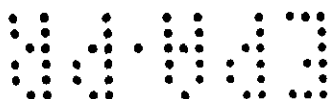

DURA-TABS—Slow dissolving tablets to provide continuous chlorination to prevent algae

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the directions on the label of these products. Initially pre-condition your pool water with ECONOCHLOR liquid or POWDERED ECONOCHLOR.

RECOMMENDED DOSAGE: For each 15,000 gals. of pool water, place 10 tablets in the skimmer basket. Allow 8 to 12 hrs. for chlorine residual to equalize. Initial treatment will depend on water temperature and flow rate through the skimmer. Chlorine should be maintained between 1.5 and 2.0 ppm as determined by a suitable test kit. If daily chlorine level is too low, increase the number of tablets in the skimmer basket. If daily chlorine level is higher than 2.0 ppm, reduce the number of tablets accordingly.

Once every two weeks a shock dose of 5 ppm chlorine should be made to prevent resistant species of algae. DURA-TABS are not recommended for this purpose. Properly used at the rate of 1/2 lb. per each 10,000 gallons of water will satisfy this requirement in conjunction with DURA-TABS. Keep pH of water between 7.2 and 7.6 as determined by a suitable test kit.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS-HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed or enters respiratory tract. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing immediately.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID): If swallowed feed bread soaked in milk or cooking oil. Call a physician immediately.

If on skin: Brush off excess chemical and flush skin with cold water for at least 15 minutes. If persists, get medical attention.

If in eyes: Flush with cold water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into ponds or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES Permit. For more information, contact your regional office of EPA.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS—STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT: Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Do not add this product to any container containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction, explosion, or fire. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may result in a reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not re-seal or re-use the container in open air or well-ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of fire, remove container if possible and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve remaining material. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area. Do not burn.
