DIRECTIONS FOR USE: COMBAT is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools. For maximum effectiveness, pools containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using COMBAT.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 14 to 21 fl. oz. of COMBAT per 10,000 gal. of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 8 to 14 fl. oz. of COMBAT per 10,000 gal. of water.
