1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

a. Under the heading USE DIRECTIONS add the following misuse directions.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in manner inconsistent with its labeling.

b. Under the heading SANITATION change the first sentence to read as follows:

To sanitize nonfood contact inanimate hard surfaces such as walls and floors in

c. Remove Tetrasodium salt of ethylenediamine tetracetic acid from the Active Ingredients [REDACTED]



USE DIRECTIONS:

FOR CLEANING:

Lightly Soiled Areas - surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1 oz. of PENETONE DC per gallon of water.

Heavily Soiled Areas - mop or brush soiled surfaces with a solution containing 2-3 oz. per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned surface with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION:

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard surfaces in homes, schools, restaurants, restrooms and other public areas, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 1 oz. per gallon of water. Surfaces that are heavily soiled should be cleaned with 1-2 oz. per gallon of water then disinfected.

To disinfect locker rooms, shower stalls, walkways around pools and other areas against pathogenic fungi, mop area with a solution containing ¼ oz. in 1 gallon of water. This solution will destroy *Trichophyton interdigitale*, a causative agent of athlete's foot.

SANITATION:

To sanitize walls, floors in food processing plants, first clean thoroughly with a solution containing ¼ oz. per gallon of water. If surface is heavily soiled, use PENETONE DC at the rate of 2-3 oz. per gallon of water to insure thorough cleaning. Sanitize cleaned surface with a rinse solution containing ½ oz. of PENETONE DC per gallon of water.

DEODORIZATION:

To deodorize surfaces during cleaning, mop or brush surfaces with a solution containing 2 oz. per gallon of water. PENETONE DC is an effective antibacterial cleaner designed for use in industrial and
