THEORETICAL STATEMENTS

Hazards to humans and domestic animals

May cause irritation of nose, throat, eyes and skin. Do not breathe dust. PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Dilute by giving 2 glasses of water to drink. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician at once.
IF INHALED: Move subject to fresh air.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Consult a physician if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Wash affected skin areas with soap and water.

NOTE TO PHYSICIANS: Warning symptoms—methomyl poisoning produces effects associated with anticholinesterase activity which may include weakness, blurred vision, headache, nausea, abdominal cramps, discomfort in chest, constriction in pupils, sweating, slow pulse, muscle tremors. Atropine is antidotal. Do not use morphine or 2-PAM.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ENDANGERED SPECIES RESTRICTIONS

The following restrictions apply to use of this product after February 1, 1988:

STORAGE

CABBAGE, BROCCOLI, CAULIFLOWER: Beet armyworm, flea beetle, cricket. Control: use 15-60 lbs. per acre (14).

CANTALOUPE, WATERMELON: Armyworm and cricket control use 15-60 lbs. per acre. Do not permit workers to handle crop within 24 hours.

COTTON: Cutworms, crickets, grasshoppers, flea beetles. Do not apply within 3 days after last application.

LETTUCE (Head): apply 15-60 lbs. per acre. Do not permit workers to handle crop within 24 hours.

SUGAR BEETS: Beet armyworm control use 15-60 lbs. per acre. Do not permit workers to handle crop within 24 hours.

SWEET CORN: apply 15-30 lbs. per acre. Do not permit workers to handle crop within 3 days after last application.

TOMATOES: apply 30-60 lbs. per acre. Do not permit workers to handle crop within 24 hours.
