BROCCOLI, CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER: For control of cabbage looper, flee beetle and stink bug. Apply 15 to 20 lbs. on cauliflower before the edible parts start to form: 15 to 25 lbs. on broccoli and cabbage. 14 days.

COTTON: For control of aphids, bollworm, cabbage looper, cotton leaf perforator, cotion stink bug, lygus bug. Apply 10 to 30 lbs. Do not apply after bolls begin to open. Do not graze meat or dairy animals in treated fields.

HEAD LETTUCE: For control of cabbage looper, aphids. Apply 20 to 25 lbs. product per acre. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest. Remove wrapper leaves at harvest. Do not feed crop refuse to livestock. Do not apply more than 3 times after thinning.

MELONS: For control of aphids, cucumber beetle, striped cabbage flea beetle. Apply 20 to 35 lbs. per acre. 1 day.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

ROCKWOOD BRAND MALATION THIO SULFUF 5-4-20 should be applied to dry foliage at time when the air is still, using ground equipment or aircraft. Make thorough coverage of plants with a uniform deposit of dust. Apply at first sign of infestation and repeat at regular intervals when needed to maintain control, but observe use limits given for specific crops. To be used only by thoroughly trained operators familiar with the handling of hazardous insecticides. For brevity, days indicate interval L tween final treatment and harvest.
